Jan. 31st Webinar: Fitness Assessment in Illinois: Tools, Resources, and Information You Need

- Reporting and a tour of the free Illinois-specific Excel spreadsheet

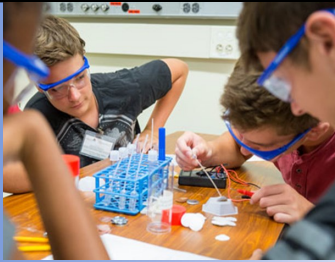

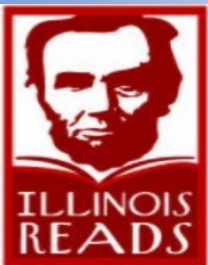
